



- Popplet An online App that makes writing fun








USING CURRENT EVENTS AS A READING AND THEN A WRITING TOOL

Different ways to write a current event

- What, when, where, why, who, how
- Using the six thinking hats
- Summarising

- The Reading Part:
 Read a current event with your child
- Discuss what it means
- Ask questions about the current event (what, when... or the six thinking hats)
- Use a tool from 'Sheena Cameron' finding the 'Main Point'
- What are some of the 'Main points' in the article?

The Writing Part:

- Write down what the main points of the article are
- Discuss whether these are proper sentences
- Eventually they could write their sentences into paragraphs
- This is 'Summarise' which is another one of 'Sheena Cameron's' strategies
- To summarise is to sum it up using your own words
