

## CELEBRATING RELIGIOUS EDUCATION IN OUR

**SCHOOL** This week I was delighted to visit Rooms 19 and 20 while they were having a Religious Education/Science session. In RE the classes are learning about who, what, where and how the Holy Spirit works. To help the students more fully understand about the Holy Spirit, Mrs Higby and Mrs McKeown had planned a number of practical activities that enabled the students to discover how the Holy Spirit works in our



lives. Who is the Holy Spirit? This activity involved the students breaking an egg to clearly see the three distinct parts that make up an

egg. Through having some carefully chosen scripture links the students worked through a range of questions. "The parts of an egg- shell, yolk and the white stuff can be separated but they are still an egg. Even though we talk about the Holy Spirit, it is part of God." Shion Rm 19

Why do we need the Holy Spirit in our lives? This activity involved the students comparing two drinks, one stirred and one not stirred, of Chocolate

The tournament is a prestigious tournament to be held in the first week of the July school holidays, at the Hautapu Rugby grounds, Cambridge. This tournament has been going since the early 1920's.

This tournament is for young boys and girls who are 56 kgs and under, who are Year 8 or below. Normally the players come from the intermediate school level, however we do have the odd Year 6 who is an exceptional player that does get selected.

This is a Primary and Intermediate school based tournament which means you must trial for the team in the area in which you go to school. The other difference is, you don't have to play rugby to be eligible but you still must trial to enable selection.
