Your username is the email address that you have previously shared with the school. Enter your email and then click **Get New Password**. If you have issues logging on or are unsure of your email address then please email jmcintyre@marian.school.nz using your preferred email address.

#### Step 3

An email will be sent to you containing a link for you to **click on**. The link will take you to a page where you will see your new password. If you choose to personalise this, you can delete the generated password and **enter your own strong, secure password**.

#### Step 4

Click 'Menu': Click on each photo of your child to view your child's learning.

The 'dollar' sign is where you are able to access your invoices.

The NZEI primary teachers' union will be taking industrial action on **Wednesday 15th August**. This will affect the whole day.

There is a very real crisis in education in New Zealand. Ever increasing class sizes and teacher workloads, combined with insufficient funding and a shortage of new teacher graduates, is placing a

huge amount of pressure on the profession. Teachers are leaving the job in droves and we are experiencing fewer and fewer relief teachers available. We need to take a stand to safeguard our profession for our children and help make teaching an attractive career option for young graduates.

Most NZEI members are reluctant to strike, but see this action as an investment in our children's' future. It is precisely because we care so much about our students and maintaining a good quality education system that we are prepared to give up a day's worth of our own salaries to make our voices heard.
