Focus for the Week: The Bread of Life John 6: 51-58

In this week's gospel, Jesus tells us that He is "The Bread of Life" and anyone who eats this bread will live forever. At the Last Supper, Jesus changed the bread and wine into His own body and blood.

Through the power of the Holy Spirit, they became Jesus himself so that He could share himself in a very special way with his apostles.

At the offertory, we bring bread and wine to be changed, through the power of God, into his body and blood so that we can share in Christ's life and become more like Jesus. To be the hands, face and voice of Jesus to those we meet.

Sometimes when we can try to do something and it does not work out the way we expect or want it to, it is very tempting to give up. Next time you find yourself in that situation do yourself a favour and... STOP, then ask yourself ... "how can I fix this or make it better?"
