First Sunday of Advent (Luke 21: 25-28, 34-36)
Last Sunday we began the season of Advent, a time that we prepare ourselves for Christmas. Everyone is very busy getting ready to celebrate the birthday of Jesus. What else must be ready for? Jesus is living in our world today, and we know that he will return in glory at the end of time. We must be ready to welcome him into our hearts and our lives.

How should we do this? Jesus came to share his love, forgiveness, peace and happiness with the world. If we share these gifts of his love with people we meet every day by small acts of kindness or



goodness, then we will be ready to fully enjoy the celebrations which take place at Christmas and at the end of time.
