#### **Focus for the Week**

#### **Face to Face with Jesus**

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time Luke 5: 1-11 How would we behave if we suddenly found ourselves in the Divine Presence of our Lord Jesus Christ.

In Sunday's Gospel reading, Peter our first Pope said to Jesus "I am not worthy of you." He thought he wasn't good enough. Like us he was weak and he made mistakes. What was most important of all was that he had a sincere heart and he overcame his weaknesses by placing his complete trust in the Lord God.

The main point in today's Gospel reading is that Jesus does not make junk.

He made us all with talents and we are part of Him. So how would we behave if we suddenly found ourselves in the Divine Presence of the Lord Jesus?

Jesus is physically present in the Holy Eucharist and in the Holy Tabernacle and of course the Holy Spirit is always with us. Without necessarily realising it, we are always in the Divine Presence of our Lord.

On Tuesday and today Sr Anne has worked in each classroom sharing prayer and Christian meditation.

## Welcome "Celebrating Te Reo and Specialist Music"

On Friday we welcomed Whaea Donna back. Whaea Donna teaches Te Reo and leads our kapahaka. We are indeed fortunate to have Whaea Donna teach each Friday in our school, teaching and supporting both our staff and students as they learn Te Reo.

Sam Trenwith - Music House Music Teacher, works in our school each Wednesday teaching specialist music to our Year 5-8 students. This will include Rock Bands, Junior Band, Drum Group and Liturgy group. Students will be invited to audition and will be selected for these groups. Each term Sam will organise a performance concert for these groups.

#### **Positive Behaviour for Learning (PB4L)**

This year our school has been selected to receive additional Ministry of Education funding to train and implement Positive Behaviour for Learning (PB4L) programme across the school. PB4L helps to foster positive behaviour, strengthen relationships, and increase student well-being by creating caring, inclusive learning environments. Research shows that such environments have positive effects on children's and students' behaviour, resilience, learning, and achievement. As we begin our training we will establish a leadership team for PB4L and work closely with our parent community to review our current practices and develop consistent procedures across the school.
