#### **Focus for the Week**

#### **Gospel - 8th Sunday of Ordinary Time** Luke 6:39-45

The Gospel this week is a challenge to us all to avoid all kinds of pride. We are asked to look at ourselves and examine our own failings and deficiencies. It is easy to see the faults of others and ridicule them but harder to see these faults in ourselves. We are urged to reflect on our own lives and our actions. A humble person is always truthful, even if the truth hurts because he is ready to admit his faults and sins. Good people produce good words and good deeds.

#### Today is ASH WEDNESDAY

This morning the students all attended Mass and received the ashes on their forehead. Ash Wednesday signals the beginning of Lent, a time of preparation and reflection for the coming of Easter. By



observing the 40 days of Lent, we replicate Jesus' sacrifice and time in the desert for 40 days.

#### **Charism Focus**

Charism focus for this week are focusing on being a good friend to others by being trustworthy, honest and inclusive.

So how do we find the truth? How do we know what we read, see and hear is the truth? It has to come back to personal integrity and the values we hold.
