### Focus for the Week

#### The Body and Blood of Christ

Luke 9: 11-17

On Sunday we celebrated the Feast of Corpus Christi or the Body and Blood of Christ. The Church is often referred to as the Body of Christ. Jesus comes to us in the meal of the Eucharist. Through the body and blood of Jesus, we have the sign of God's presence within us. Without this communion, we are divided, homeless and without eternal life. Through this communion we are made one and have the life that will go on forever and we are strengthened until Jesus comes again.

### Charism Focus

Our Charism focus for this term is LIVE FAITH. We celebrated Corpus Christi on Sunday - The Body and Blood of Christ. An important part of our faith and belief is that we recognise the real presence of Jesus when we receive communion.

But how do we share the love of Jesus that we receive, as we go through our day? Jesus wants God's love to be shown through us, to people we meet and spend time with.

Our school motto is **To bring Christ into the World.** To bring Christ into the world means to bring love. Pope Francis wants us all to reflect on what love we bring to others:
