Focus for the Week

Gospel Reflection: Jesus is Tempted in the Desert

Matthew 4: 1-11 First Sunday in Lent

In this week's Gospel reading, Jesus, proclaimed Son of God at his baptism, is subjected to a triple temptation. Obedience to the Father is a characteristic of being a true son, and so the devil does his best to get Jesus to rebel against God. Each refusal of Jesus is expressed in language taken from the Book of Deuteronomy (Dt 8:3; 6:13, 16). The temptations of Jesus echo those of Israel during the wandering in the desert and later in Canaan. The victory of Jesus, the true Israel and the true Son, is in contrast to the failure of the ancient and disobedient "son," the old Israel.

During this season of Lent, we are called to take an honest look at our lives. What tempts us away from God? What is stopping us from completely trusting in his path for us and surrendering our lives to his will?

Charism Focus

Our Charism Focus for this term is the value of LIVE LOVE. The gospel today tells us how to pray- how to talk to God and show our forgiveness of others when they do something wrong.

We ask in our **prayer** for God's **love** and to use that **love** to **show** others. Help us **show** patience and forgiveness with those around us.. At Marian School we have the models of our founders Euphraise Barbier and Marellin Champagnat who lived their lives always praying to God and being open to God's Love in the way they treated others.

So what does that mean to us this week at Marian School? Bring Christ into the World is our motto. We

need to ask God in prayer to work through us - to be the hands, face and voice of Jesus in our dealings with others. Giving friends another chance, looking for people who need a smiling face and a helping hand.

By this, everyone will know that you are my disciples: if you love one another" John Chapter 13: verse 35

Please be aware that we do not grade teams at Marian Catholic School for years 1-6. I will do my best to keep teams who have played together in the past together, however, I cannot guarantee it. We also need to not have too many children in a team. It is no fun for the child, the coach or the parents on the sideline to have kids spending more time off the court/field and on. Depending on final numbers in each age group, some children may miss out or be placed in a team older than their age group.

All netball, hockey and basketball teams require a coach and manager to look after the team. Netball and hockey teams also need to supply an umpire for every game (this cannot be the teams coach). It is very important that people volunteer their time for this and are willing to put their hands up to help. Without it, I am unable to register teams to play, and the kids miss out. Please be aware that sometimes we are fortunate enough to have young students that offer to umpire. If this is the case, you may be asked to provide a small donation to pay the student.
