Gospel Focus for the Week

Gospel Reflection: Mark 14: 22-24

On Sunday we celebrated the Feast of Corpus Christi or the Body and Blood of Christ. One of the names for the Church is the Body of Christ. We, as part of the church, become the Body of Christ when we act in the ways of Jesus, by being present to the hungry and the broken. For example, sitting with a sick friend, listening to someone who is troubled, feeding a child, preparing a family dinner, and sharing a meal with a stranger. These are life giving acts. We are bringing the presence of Jesus into our everyday lives when we are presented with these opportunities. How can we bring Eucharist to each other - bringing Christ into the world by our words and actions.

Charism Focus for the Week

Our Charism focus for this term is LIVE FAITH. This week we are focusing on our two founders Euphrasie Barbier and Marcellin Champagnat and how they lived their faith.

When we see examples of people like Euphrasie Barbier and Marcellin Champagnat, we understand what being a follower of Jesus looks like. They both loved God, and other people could tell they were Christian by the way they treated others.

Euphrasie and Marcellin had a strong faith and belief in God but it wasn't just words - they lived their faith. Praying, helping and caring for people, especially those who were lonely or in need.

So what can we learn from our Founders, Euphrasie Barbier and Marcellin Champagnat? As pupils of Marian Catholic school we look to our founders as models of how we can live our faith - to share the love of Jesus and show to others that we are followers of Christ, being the hands, face and voice of Jesus.

The policies and procedures are tailored to our school, and the school supplies specific information such as our charter, and procedures for behaviour management, reporting to parents, etc.

SchoolDocs updates, modifies, or creates policies in response to changes in legislation or Ministry



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guidelines, significant events, reviews/requests from schools, and regular reviewing from the *SchoolDocs* team. Our board of trustees has the opportunity to view changes/additions and comment on them before they are implemented. We will follow a three-year review cycle for the policies and will advise you when policies are up for review and how you can take part in the review.
